

### AREA ONE ACT COMMITTEE

Don Butler reports that the drug overdose epidemic continues....29 deaths so far in our community compared to 30 total deaths in 2016. There have been 119 injuries so far in 2017. Heroin cut with fentanyl is now one of the leading causes of death. Fentanyl is 40-50 times more potent than heroin, most users don't know what is mixed with the heroin. New Hampshire just joined the growing list of states suing the opioid pharma companies. Virginia has yet to do so. Three Virginians die every day from drug overdose.

#### **NICE UPDATE**

Don also noted that the female drug court participant whom he spoke to us about last winter is making great progress thanks to donations from our club.

She is now in the 4th stage of the drug court, has a job and an apartment and is an incredibly positive person. He said that our club certainly helped change her world. *Thank you all!*


#### HEALTH TIP
